


Why Should I Hire A DJ?

Gone are the days when you hire a DJ just to play music. DJ's do a lot more than just show up to your event and put on some fun dance music. Even if you are not planning on having dancing at your event, it's a wise choice to hire a DJ. Here are a few reasons why:

- **Your DJ can act as the MC (Master Of Ceremonies).** At some events, especially weddings, you are going to want certain things done at certain times. Your DJ can keep track of the time, and let you know when it's time to get ready for those specific events (cake cutting, toasts, first dance, etc.). Your DJ can also make the announcement and get your guests ready for what's to come. A good DJ will meet with you beforehand and discuss all of the important events that will be taking place and the timeline you want them to be done.
- **Your DJ can provide *sound* for your wedding ceremony or event.** This is especially important for outdoor ceremonies. There's nothing worse than going to a wedding, having to sit in the back, and not hear a word that the officiator says. Your DJ can provide speakers, microphones, and anything else needed for the ceremony. We have a wireless lapel microphone to clip onto the officiator. We can also plug in guitars, keyboards, and any other musical instrument that is being used during your ceremony. Your DJ will also be present during the ceremony to control volume levels. This is especially important if you have an officiator that speaks really softly, or on the other hand, has a really loud voice. Your DJ will adjust the volumes accordingly from his/her station in the back to make sure the sound is not too loud or too soft.
- **Your DJ can provide *music* for your wedding ceremony.** We have a wide variety of music for you to choose from for your wedding ceremony. What if you don't like our selection? You can use any song of your choice for the ceremony. We will even try our best to find instrumental versions of your favorite songs to use during your ceremony. Don't pay for high-priced musicians when you can have your DJ do all of the work!
- **Can't I save money by loading the songs I want to have played onto an iPod/CD/MP3 Player and just play music off of that?** While this will save you money, there are a few things to consider. What if you loaded slow love songs onto your iPod, but your guests feel like dancing? What if you loaded all dance music onto your iPod, but your guests want a slow song once in a while? What if your best friend wants to dance with her husband to the song they had played at their wedding? A DJ can take requests and play what's going to keep your guests there and having a good time. A good DJ will meet with you beforehand and discuss all of your preferences, so that they will play appropriate requests only. What if a guest requests The Chicken Dance or YMCA, and you absolutely do not want them played at your wedding? If your DJ hasn't discussed all of this with you beforehand, then they won't be able to know if it's okay to play. Make sure your DJ knows all of your expectations ahead of time. Also,



your DJ will bring speakers for a balanced, surround sound so that all of your guests can hear what is being played. If you have a CD player, not everybody is going to be able to hear it.

- **Your DJ has a wide variety of music for your guests to choose from.** A good DJ will have a wide variety of music to choose from, with an organized way for your guests to see what's available. Our music library consists of over 10,000 songs in all genres of music. We have three binders of music for your guests to browse through: alphabetized by artist, alphabetized by song title, and alphabetized by genre.
